Johani is also the Founder of the Mabu Buru Foundation, which was created for the purpose of addressing the issues that he has witnessed to be threats to the Aboriginal lore and culture and its practices in the West Kimberley Region. The Mabu Buru Foundation also has a focus on maintaining, protecting and strengthening the lore and culture within the West Kimberley region. In addition to his part-time employment as a Crocodile Wrangler at the Malcolm Douglas Crocodile Park, Johani is also a Director of the Western Australia Indigenous Tourism Operator Council (WAITOC) and serves as a Cultural Research Practitioner with the Kimberley Aboriginal Lore and Culture Centre (KALACC). Johani has also recently been elected as a Local Government Council Member for the Shire of Broome.



The **Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP)** Space

What is a Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP)?

A RAP is a strategic document of a company that outlines concrete ways that they will contribute to the national reconciliation movement both internally and within their community.

What is the reconciliation movement?

At it's heart, reconciliation is about strengthening relationships between Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and non-Indigenous peoples, for the benefit of all Australians.

Who has a Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP)?

The RAP network is a diverse group of over 1,100 organisations that directly impact over 3 million Australians every day, via their workplace RAP commitments.



Challenges with current **RAP** Procurement

Lack of suitable products & services

- Despite there being several thousand registered businesses with Supply Nation, many of them are small, regionally specific or not suited to corporate/government entities.
- Most registered businesses were established with a “product” or “services” first mindset, rather than a strategic approach of “client solutions” first.

Ensuring appropriate use of profits

- There is scepticism by procurement and sustainability managers that the Indigenous businesses are not providing a benefit to Indigenous people and communities.
- Our dedication to perpetuation of Indigenous culture is steadfast.

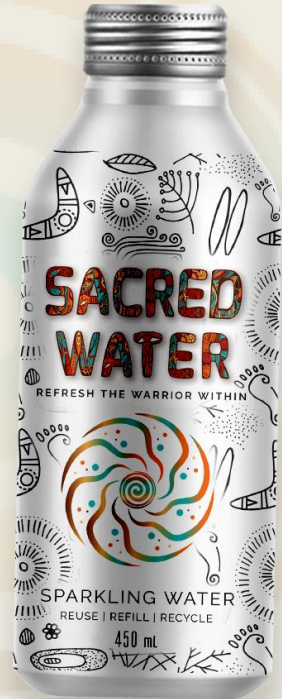
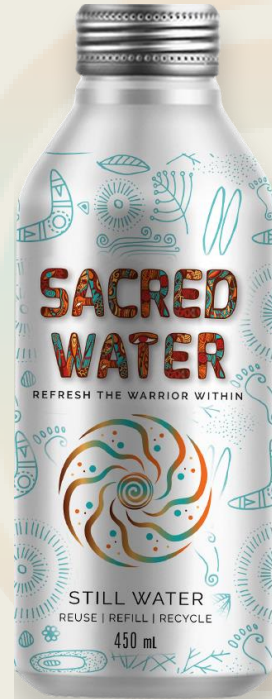

1. Smoking Ceremony

Our Smoking Ceremony consists of the explanation of the Smoking Ceremony and the importance of this ceremony for our people and our culture. We can have this as interactive if the group wishes to participate otherwise it can be more of the explanation of the Smoking Ceremony.

2. Acknowledgement/ Welcome to Country

An Acknowledgement/ Welcome to country is generally experienced for big events and or moving areas and you are being welcomed to a location by a member of the community or someone who is acknowledged and welcomed by the community.

3. Incursion to Client

We offer workplace incursions with cultural discussions, cooking demos (like Johnny cakes with native ingredients or tea tastings), and insights into land, waterways, and fire knowledge. Customize your experience with a focus on one or multiple topics to appreciate the strength of our culture today.

4. Visiting our Nursery

Join us at our Nursery for a hands-on day! Start with a Welcome to Country and a Smoking Ceremony (weather permitting), then dive into planting and propagating plants. 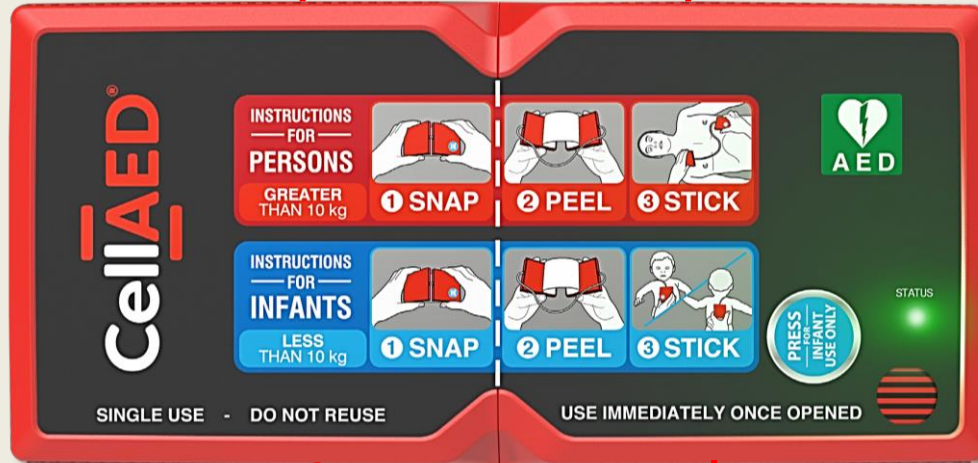
